Description

Clinician will provide trauma-informed outpatient counseling to youth/adolescents in a residential group home setting. Providers must have the ability to interact with others in an ethical, culturally sensitive and respectful manner. This person should be adaptive, flexible and responsive to the needs of the client and program. As a multi-tasker the clinician must have strong problem solving skills, ability to prioritize tasks, maintain organization, and effectively communicate verbally and in writing.

Responsibilities

- Conduct weekly individual and group counseling sessions.
- Actively participate in treatment and discharge planning meetings. - Works with the client, family and other team members to plan discharge
- Ability to effectively work on an interdisciplinary team
- Provide appropriate treatment to youth using best practice treatment modalities
- Ability to assess, diagnose, recommend, and implement treatment services for youth using an integrated approach to address mental health, medical care, and developmental needs.
- Maintain caseload and utilization by maintaining regular contact with clients 56% of the time
- Monitor and assess progress utilizing supportive methods
- Ensure accurate and timely documentation of clinical activities in compliance with contract, regulatory and agency requirements and clinical best practices
- Consult with team members concerning situations and possible courses of action
- Complete agency, accrediting body, and funder required training
- Proficient in basic computer programs, and willing to learn electronic records system applications.
- Other duties as assigned

Required Education & Experience

- Ohio Licensure -LSW or LPC
- Experience with youth/adolescent patient population
- Knowledge of or willingness to learn and apply trauma-informed care principles
- A minimum of 2 years experience in behavioral health field
- Experience providing Medicaid services is preferred but not required
